### संक्षिप्त कार्यक्रम रिपोर्ट

राष्ट्रीय सेवा योजना, जेपी इंस्टिट्यूट ऑफ इनफार्मेशन टेक्नोलॉजी, नोएडा द्वारा द्वारा दो दिवसीय अंतर-विश्वविद्यालयीय युवा संवाद कार्यक्रम का आयोजन किया गया. कार्यक्रम का विषय था : **“भारत : 2047”**. इस कार्यक्रम में दिल्ली विश्वविद्यालय के अंतर्गत आने वाले विभिन्न महाविद्यालयों के लगभग 76 विद्यार्थियों ने भाग लिया जबकि मेजबान संस्थान के 70 विद्यार्थियों की हिस्सेदारी हुई.

“भारत :2047” विषय के अंतर्गत विद्यार्थियों ने कुल सात मुद्दों पर अपने व्यापक विचार साझा किये जिससे स्वतंत्रता के 100 वर्ष पूरे करने तक भारत विकसित देश बन सकता है. विद्यार्थियों के कुछ महत्वपूर्ण संवाद निम्नलिखित हैं:

#### 1. आर्थिक विकास और नवाचार
