# **General Guidelines**

## Dear Students,

- 1. Congratulations on your admission to JIIT NOIDA. Your schedule of reporting to the Campus is given in paragraphs below.
- 2. Students to report to the respective campuses as per the allotment letters for Registration.
- 3. **Schedule of Activities** for newly admitted students will be as follows:
  - (a) Reporting of Hostellers and Hostel accommodation allocation
  - (b) Registration of subjects
  - (c) Induction Program and Commencement of Academic Activities and Classes

## **Reporting of Hostellers**

- 4. Hostellers are required to report to the Campus as follows:
  - (a) 14 Jul All UG programs
  - (b) 15 Jul- Diploma
  - (c) 23 Jul- PG and Lateral

### **Induction Program and commencement of Academic Activities and Classes**

- 6. The Induction/Orientation program will be held for UG and Diploma programs. The induction program and academic activities (conduct of classes) will commence as follows:
  - (a) 16 Jul UG programs (BTech, Integrated MTech, BCA, BSc & BBA)
  - (b) 17 Jul- Diploma
  - (c) 24 Jul- PG programs (MTech, MSc, MCA & MBA) and Lateral Entry

#### Attendance

- 7. Students to note the following:
  - (a) On completion of registration, attendance of students is compulsory as per university rules.
  - (b) Student are required to maintain 80% attendance in all subjects.
  - (c) It is strongly advised that students maintain their attendance and not miss important initial part of curriculum.

#### **Documentation**

- 8. Candidates to bring self-attested photo copies of the following documents for verification of fulfilling the criteria for the program.
  - (a) Original Character Certificate
  - (b) Original Migration certificate
  - (c) Original Medical certificate of fitness from MBBS qualified doctor (on letter head of doctor or letter head of the hospital)
  - (d) Photo copy of Marksheet and Certificate of High School (Class 10)
  - (e) Photo copy of Marksheet of Intermediate or equivalent (Class 10+2)
  - (f) Photo copy of Marksheet of qualifying exam (for PG candidates, as applicable)
  - (g) Photo copy of Marksheet of Diploma / BTech 1st year (for Lateral Entry candidates)
  - (h) Migrant certificate (for J&K candidates as applicable)
  - (i) Photo copy of AADHAAR card
  - (j) Four copies of passport size colored photographs.
  - (k) Anti-Ragging Affidavit Candidates to fill online anti-ragging proforma at link https://antiragging.in/ (The procedure of same is available at JIIT website under important links).
  - (I) Original of documents at Serial (a), (b) & (c) to be deposited and at Serial (d) to (h), as applicable, to be produced for verification during registration.
  - (m) Serial (k) Print out of the online submission of anti-ragging to be brought along for depositing, duly signed by student and parent/guardian.
  - (n) In case a student is not able to submit any document listed above for the reason beyond control, the student shall be allowed to submit the same latest by <u>30 September 2024</u> after giving an undertaking. In case the student fails to submit the documents by the stipulated date, the admission shall stand cancelled automatically.

<u>Note</u>: Students are required to bring self-attested photocopies of the documents mentioned above. The required originals given in para-4 above are required to be produced for verification.

- 9. **Hostel.** The students who have been offered hostel accommodation in campus and deposited the hostel charges will be allotted hostel room on arrival. Other important points:
  - (a) Double occupancy in each room. Hostel charges are Rs 1,00,000/- per semester.
  - (b) Allocation of hostel is for Odd Sem 2024 only.
  - (c) Reporting of Hostellers to campus as per schedule.
  - (d) List of hostel items attached.
- 10. The following documents will be available on JIIT Website latest by 15 July 2024. Students are advised to go through the same.
  - (a) Time-Table for Odd Sem 2024 (1st Sem)
  - (b) Induction Program & Schedule
- 11. General Points. Following points are reiterated: -
  - (a) Bring a soft/hard copy of your admission offer letter.
  - (b) Show the offer letter for entry into Campus.
  - (c) Students to report to respective campuses for Registration.
  - (d) Students to adhere to Registration timings as given in para 3 above.
  - (e) Students will be issued temporary identity cards on their arrival in respective campuses.
  - (f) Bus facility will be available from Sector 62 to 128 campus for hostellers allotted seats in 128 Campus.
  - (g) Students desirous of availing regular bus service (from 62 to 128 campus) to contact Dr Suneet Awasthi at Sector 128.
  - (h) Parents/Guardians may accompany the candidate for Registration.
