
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
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
1. STUDENT SATISFACTION SURVEY
















































The institute/ teachers use student centric methods, such as experiential learning, project-based learning, participative learning, and problem-solving methodologies for enhancing learning experiences.











2. PARENTS' FEEDBACK-

The parents of students are important stakeholders for JIIT. We seek the feedback of all the parents through feedback forms sent through email. This year, a total of 83 parents of B. Tech, BBA, BCA, Integrated M. Tech, MBA, MSc and PhD course students from various departments - ECE, CSE and IT, Math, Physics and, Biotechnology Departments, JBS, and HSS have responded to our request for feedback.

They were asked to rate JIIT as Outstanding, Excellent, Very Good, Good and Fair on 15 parameters. Overall, approximately 22% of parents rated the parameters as Outstanding, 33% as Excellent, 21% as Very Good, 17% as Good, and 7% as Fair.

Figure 1: Parents' Feedback- Overall (Post Graduate and PhD Students)






Figure 2: Parents' Feedback- Overall (Undergraduate Students)





3. ALUMNI FEEDBACK-

Feedback from alumni has been collected through an online form shared through mail. 61 alumni responded to our request for feedback, of which 80.3% were enrolled in the B. Tech program, 11.47% in the MTech program, 1.6% in the MBA program and 6.56% were enrolled in the PhD program. Alumni details have been given in the following table.

As per the responses of alumni for one of the questionnaires "The curriculum and syllabus content were appropriate for my placement / higher education", most of the students' feedback is agree. Almost similar responses are received for other questionnaires like: "The learning ambience at the institute is good", "All the academic processes of the institute are transparent", "The institute is student-centric in all its academic initiatives", "The institute/faculty helped me in placement / higher education", "The institute provides sufficient opportunity to participate in extracurricular activities"

Alumni suggested to update the curriculum of JIIT for the following:

Integrate competitive coding platforms such as Leetcode and Hackerrank into the curriculum itself, since that's what most students will need during placement seasons.

In addition to the above, some suggestions are also received from our alumni, like the need for more practical learning inside the class, allowing students to focus more on industrial training opportunities so that students can gain some industrial experiences, most students in the Biotechnology branch pursue higher studies. Therefore, instead of just encouraging them to write literature reviews, faculty should motivate them to carry out experiments independently. Students should be trained to use high-end lab equipment.

A few points the Institute can consider for better education and skill: The alumni responded that the competency levels of JIITians at their current organization are generally good.





4. FACULTY FEEDBACK-

The annual feedback is sought from all faculty members of JIIT, on a total of 10 parameters related to teaching and curriculum. The faculty members were asked to rate the parameters on a 1 to 5 scale where 1 means Fair, 2 means Good, 3 means Very Good, 4 means Excellent and 5 means Outstanding.
